

Meeting called to order by Chairman Roy Moses.

Minutes of Annual Meeting 2011 were read.

Squaw Creek Irrigation will continue to bill all users of Sage Hen to keep money in an account to repairs and not have to have a special billing. The Squaw Creek Irrigation is keeping better records as to how money

is being spent.

Roy Moses reported that work was done on the corner by Schachtes A discussion about a flood gate north of the corner. The work would have to be done in August and the water would have to be shut off and stay off until the cement dries. A culvert with an end that could be shut down and opened when needed was discussed. Steve Wilfong and Wanda Gorley suggested this would be the best idea. Paul Drake made a motion to budget \$2500 to buy the pipe, dig and fit it with an end so boards could be taken out when a heavy runoff occurs. Steve Wilfong seconded motion carried.

The canyon has rock slides, trees down but the sand bags have grass growing and is holding the bank so far.

The Board are asking the home owners to spray the canal bank to keep weeds down.

The moss was worse in 2011 than 2010. Zylene is best timing and amount of water in canal is the key. Doing demossing twice a year was discussed. The longer the water is off the Zylene will do better/.

It was decided to buy 20 4x4s Redwood for the flume.

The liner is good.

It was discussed to shut stock water off the first of March in order to clean the canal.

Election of officers, Steve Wilfong made a motion to keep the Board the same seconded Joyce Arthur.

Brian Spears proxied 6 acres to Richard Rex in order for him to have 10 shares to hold a seat on the Board. Motion carried.

Bull Trout in Squaw Creek was discussed.
